

Arkansas State Thespian Festival Team Challenge: SET DESIGN

Guidelines

- Each design team will have 90 Minutes to <u>design and construct</u> a scenic model. At the end of the 90 Minutes, each team area must be completely cleaned.
- The following must be placed in the Designated judging area by the end of the 90 Minutes:
 - a. A Complete Set Design Packet
 - i. Set Design Score Sheet filled out w/all specified info
 - ii. Complete Set Design Concept Statement (printed legibly)
 - iii. One (1) Ground Plan
 - iv. One (1) Set Rendering
 - b. One (1) complete Scenic Model
- Each design team must ensure that their Troupe **Number**, School Name, and ALL **Team Member Names** are legibly written on your *Set Design Score Sheet* and all required information is filled out on every page of their design packet.
- Design teams are required to supply their own printer paper cardboard box (11" x 17" x 9 1/2") to construct their model in. The box may not be altered.
- Each team's set design model must fit in and remain in their cardboard box.
- Each design team should work together and collaborate on all design decisions.
- Teams may NOT USE spray paint, spray adhesives, open flame or any other hazardous materials.
- Design teams will receive a rubric, summary and a scenic description list to choose from. *These materials are for reference use only. Please only write where instructed on the papers.*
- Electronic devices are not to be used for research and should be avoided during the competition.
